## Training

"Exercise yourself toward godliness. For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come." - 1Timothy 4:7-8 NKJV

In the Roman world, gymnasiums were centers of physical training, but also places where philosophy, literature, and music were taught. Every important Roman city had at least one. Physical fitness is still a thriving business today.

When Paul encouraged Timothy to "exercise himself" toward godliness, he used a Greek word from which we get the English words "gymnasium" and "gymnastics." Using such a familiar term, Paul was urging Timothy to think about how our physical bodies develop: They need proper diet and exercise. To grow properly, our minds, muscles, and bones need to be used correctly, and often, or they will waste away.

The same things are true in our spiritual lives: We must constantly grow and develop spiritually. As Christians, we are "born again" when we accept Jesus as our Savior. But, as new Believers, we are like babies. Paul wrote, "I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able to receive it" (1 Corinthians 3:2). We need to grow, and we need to keep growing through exercise and training.

We must mature as Believers and become disciplined about our Christian faith. In the same way that an athlete exercises in order to get in shape, we must exercise ourselves spiritually. This means studying the Bible, putting Biblical principles into practice, praying, sharing the Gospel, and being careful to avoid the places, people, and things that will weaken our faith and keep us from growing spiritually.

No matter how long you've been a Christian, you must keep growing in your faith. Don't be content with a mediocre faith, seek to mature and become more like Christ. Draw closer to God. Exercise yourself toward Godliness. And stand boldly for all the things Jesus stood for.

Pray this prayer with me each morning...

Father, help me to grow in my faith. I seek more of Your Truth. Keep me from compromise. Give me boldness, and help me make a difference in the lives of others. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Chef's Corner

Sometimes you need to make a fancy looking dessert and this just might be the one for this summer. It's a blend of banana cake and banana pudding. Easy, delicious and a looker!

### Banana Pudding Cake

#### Ingredients

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 3/4 cups sugar
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 1/2 cup buttermilk
- 3 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups mashed ripe banana
- 1 (3.4-ounce) box instant vanilla pudding mix
- 1 (8-ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- 1 1/2 cups heavy whipping cream
- 1 box Nilla wafers
- 4 medium bananas, thinly sliced



#### Frosting

- 1 cup Challenge butter, softened
  - 5 cups confectioners' sugar
- 1 (8-ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed

#### Instructions

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray 3 (9-inch) round cake pans with baking spray with flour.
1. In a large mixing bowl, combine flour, sugar, baking soda, and salt.
  2. Add oil, buttermilk, eggs, and vanilla extract and beat on medium-low speed with an electric mixer until smooth.
  3. Beat in mashed banana.
  4. Pour batter into prepared pans doing your best to fill them with equal amounts.
  5. Place in oven and bake 20 to 25 minutes or until a wooden toothpick inserted in center comes out clean.
  6. Let cakes cool in pans for 10 minutes and then remove to wire racks to cool completely.
  7. Place pudding mix and cream cheese in a medium bowl and beat with a mixer set to low speed until smooth. Gradually add in cream and beat until mixture is very thick.
  8. Arrange about 15-18 vanilla wafers on top of one of the cake layers. Use a spatula to spread half of the pudding mixture on top of the wafers. Top with 1/2 of the banana slices placed in a single layer.
  9. Place a second layer of cake on top of bananas, and repeat layers: vanilla wafers, pudding mixture, and bananas.
  10. Top with final layer of cake.
  11. Make frosting. Beat butter in a large bowl until creamy. Slowly add confectioners' sugar, beating until smooth. Add whipped topping and beat until evenly mixed in.
  12. Spread frosting over top and sides of cake. Decorate with vanilla wafers.
  13. Cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate up to 3 days
